Duties of the Commission:

The duties of the Commission shall be to promote public interest in the general improvement of the environment of the cities of Athens, Etowah, Calhoun, Englewood, Niota, and the County of McMinn; to initiate, plan, direct, and coordinate programs for litter control for the community on a sustainable basis; to study, investigate, and develop plans for improving the health, sanitation, safety, and cleanliness of the cities and county.

The Commission shall consist of no more than twenty-four voting members, who shall be residents of McMinn County. Nine members shall be appointed by the McMinn County Mayor and nine members by the Mayor of Athens. The Mayor of Etowah shall appoint three members to the Commission, with the mayors of Calhoun, Englewood, and Niota appointing one member each to the Commission. The mayors of Athens, Etowah, Calhoun, Englewood, Niota, the McMinn County Mayor, and the President of the Athens and Etowah Chambers of Commerce shall serve as non-voting ex-officio members of the Commission.
