BEER ENFORCEMENT POLICY
January 21, 1997
(Revised May 20, 2003)

1. A report shall be made quarterly (March, June, September, and December), or as requested by the Chief of Police, on a form to be provided by the City (*see attachment*) by the 20th of the month after the end of the quarter, and such report shall show the amount of gross sales and the amount of beer sales, as established in 8-211 of the Athens Municipal Code, as follows:
 - (i) Restaurants. *A restaurant shall be defined as an establishment having a minimum indoor seating capacity of 30, whose principal business is serving food for consumption on premises, and whose monthly beer sales shall not exceed 25% of the monthly gross sales of the business. Any such establishment which for two consecutive months or for any three months in any calendar year has beer sales exceeding 25% of its gross sales shall have its beer permit revoked.*
 - (ii) Golf Course. *A golf course is defined as a recreational facility developed for the primary sport of golf, not to be less than nine holes, managed and regularly maintained by the operator of the facility and located on a minimum of 50 contiguous acres. To qualify as a golf course hereunder, receipts from the sales of beer shall not exceed 30% of the total gross receipts for two consecutive months or for any three months in any calendar year for the business establishment.*
2. Refusal of cooperation: Any permittee, his agent, or employee who refuses to open, or disclose his or her records to, or furnish information to, any member of the Athens Police Department upon any matter relating to or arising out of the conduct of the permittee's premises, shall subject the permittee to revocation or suspension.
3. Access to licensee premises: Immediate access, without a warrant, to all parts of the licensed premise shall be accorded members of the Athens Police Department.
